

- But I digress...


Why SLR?

HDR & AEB

- HDR = High Dynamic Range
- Range of tricks to make dazzling pictures
- AEB = Auto Exposure Bracketing
- F-stops, Apertures, fun fun fun
- AEB: take 2-9+ pictures with differing F-stops
- Use HDR software to combine them
