POSITION: Technical Analyst – UNIX and SAN Admin

PRIMARY OBJECTIVE:

Under the direction of the Supervisor, Technical Services leads in the planning, design, installation, optimization and administration of our UNIX servers and SAN infrastructure.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensure the availability of our critical UNIX based systems by monitoring, identifying and proactively resolving potential problem areas, maintaining current patch levels, and ensuring backup and DR system integrity.
- Maintain up-to-date policies, standards and procedures in all primary areas, under the direction of the Technical Services Supervisor, where appropriate.
- Act as project lead in the design and review of new server systems, applications, and upgrades.
- Accept and/or identify business unit challenges, and obtain the solution through acquired knowledge, creativity, and available resources.
- Lead projects of small to medium sizes using project management methodologies.
- Shift work and occasional travel may be required.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Degree, Diploma or Certificate in one of the following: Computer Science, Mathematics, Electronics, or other science-related field.
- Minimum two years of experience with applied knowledge of UNIX, SAN and DR technologies.
- Technical knowledge of Sun Solaris, EMC SAN, Citrix, Windows 7/XP/2000, Lotus Domino/Notes, and LAN/WAN infrastructures would be a definite asset.
- Bilingual in French/English would be considered a strong asset.
