- Maintain up-to-date policies, standards and procedures including Disaster Recovery Plan, under the direction of the Technical Services Supervisor, where appropriate.
- Act as a lead in the coordination, development, training, and mentorship of junior team members.
- Accept and/or identify complex business unit challenges, and obtain the solution through acquired knowledge, creativity, and available resources.
- Insure continued uninterrupted operations by identifying and diagnosing problems and factors affecting network performance and security.
- Lead projects of all sizes using project management methodologies.
- Shift work and occasional travel may be required.

- Minimum four years of experience with applied knowledge of advanced firewall and web server technologies.
